Merit rule for Honours students

Eligibility

Only those who have secured at least 50% marks in aggregate and 45% marks in the subject concerned or 55% marks in the subject & 45% marks in aggregate may apply for Honours course. For S.C & S.T candidate 5% marks relaxation for Honours admission. Candidates under S.C/S.T categories will have to produce evidence from competent authority (S.D.O) , along with their application form. A student can apply for more than one Honours subject. But he must use separate Honours form for each subject. And then properly filled up application forms with the attested copies of H.S Marksheet, Registration certificate , M.P admit card , caste certificate & other relevant papers will be submitted in the college office . **Original papers will have to be produced at the time of admission.**

Aggregate means the sum of marks of best scored 5 subjects(excluding Environmental Science)

Mode of Selection

For admission to Honours course, list of the eligible candidate, according to merit will be published at the first instant and the admission will be conducted through counseling process in accordance with the intake capacity as per govt. reservation rule . List will be prepared with the aggregate and subject marks .(2%) marks from the aggregate as secured by a candidate passing the qualifying examination in a year other than the current year shall be deducted and the aggregate marks thus arrived will be taken up for consideration.
